

Spermatocele

PAINLESS, FLUID-FILLED CYST IN THE EPIDIDYMISS

Causes:

- The cause is mainly unknown but may be caused by obstruction in the tubes that carry sperm to the testicles

Symptoms:

- Lump or mass above the testicle on one side of the scrotum
- General enlargement of the scrotum
- Pain, swelling, or redness of the scrotum
- Pressure at the base of the penis

Treatment:

- Only treated when they cause pain or when there is a decrease in the blood flow to the testicle
- Spermatocelectomy: Surgical procedure to remove the spermatocele
